

PLAT OF THE TOWN OF CUSTER, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON

ORDER VACATION

LANE STREET AS SHOWN IN THE TOWN SITE OF CUSTER, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, RUNS SOUTH SOUTHWEST FROM THE 50° CORNER OF LAKE ST., INTERSECTING WITH THE MEANDERING LINE OF STEEL LAGOON LAKE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF CUSTER.

Know all men by these presents:-

That we Frederick Meyer and Conetta Meyer, his wife, and Frederick Mackintosh and Anna Mackintosh his wife, do hereby lay out and plat into town lots and streets, and along the following described tract of land, to-wit:

Beginning two and 2/3 (2.66) feet south of the west East corner of the Andrew P. Boyd Donation Land Claim in Section 34, Town 20 North Range 2 East Willamette Meridian, thence running south along the East line of said claim two thousand four hundred and fifty (2505) feet; thence west one thousand eight hundred and eighty eight and 5/8 (1888.255) feet; thence north 32° 50' 10" west one thousand and 97.633 feet; thence north six hundred and forty seven and 2/3 (647.208) feet; thence East two hundred and sixty (260) feet thence north two hundred and fifty five (255) feet; thence east one thousand (1000) feet;

thence north four hundred and twenty three and 7/8 (423.708) feet; thence north 10° 37' 10" east one thousand one hundred and forty four and 1/2 (1144.033 1/2) feet; thence east one thousand one hundred and seventy two and 7/8 (1172.765) feet to the place of beginning and containing eighty eight and 2/3 (88.712) acres more or less. The above described tract of land is a part of said Donation Land Claim, and is hereafter to be known as the town of Custer; and we do hereby donate and dedicate to the use of the public forever all the streets and alleys in said town. The width of streets and

ways of lots are as shown on this plat. Alleys are fifteen (15) feet wide, Maple, Hazel, Cedar, Pine, Oak, Cherry and Elm streets are at right angles to, and Rainier, Washington and Third streets of the north line of this tract, and Lake Street of the south west corner of lot 11 block 16, are parallel with the East line of this plat. Water Street from the south west corner of block 7 to the north line of this plat makes an angle with the street of 73° 22' 16". Lake Street from the south west corner of lot 11 block 16 to the south west corner of lot 12 block 16 makes an angle with the street of 122° 0' 20".

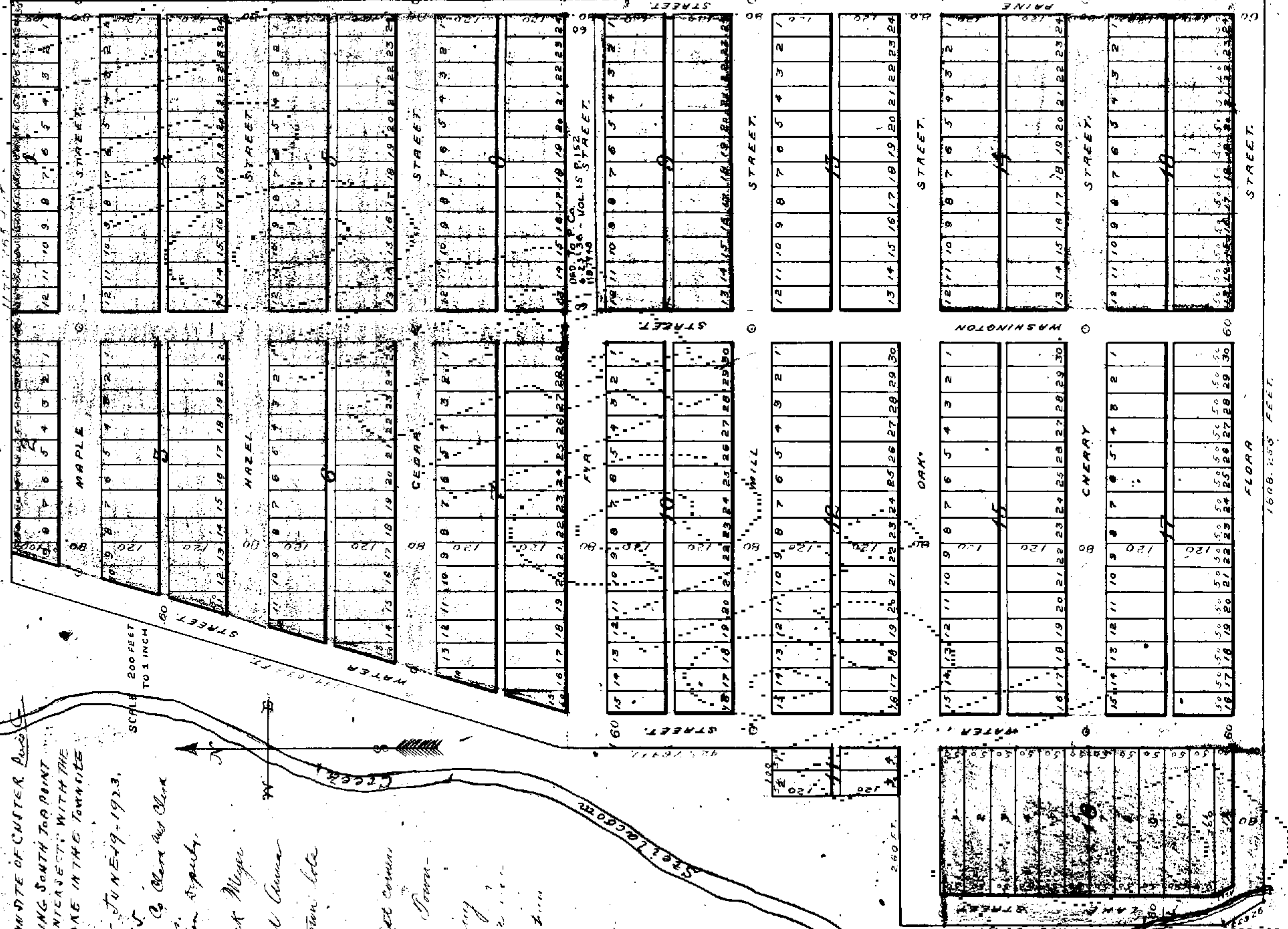

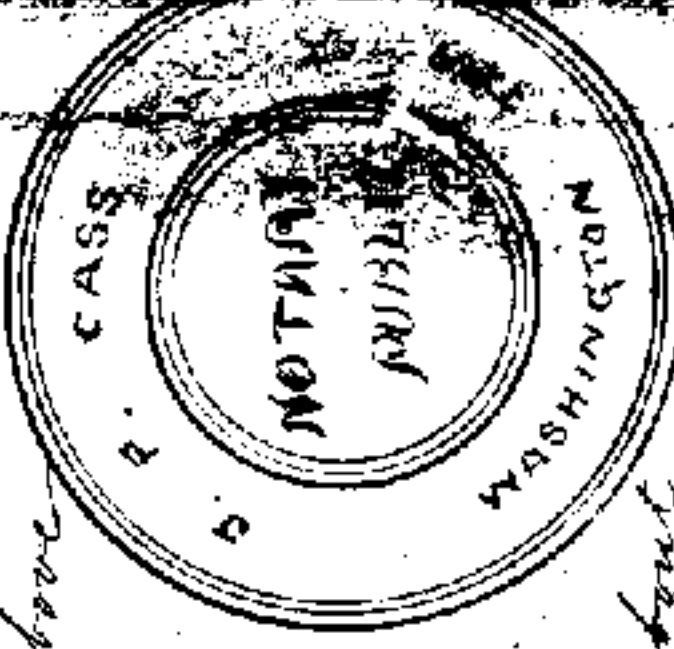
